The Health & Safety Officer program is designed to provide the HSO with tools needed to maintain a working knowledge of current applicable laws, codes and standards as identified in the Health and Safety Officer section of NFPA 1521. This interactive program also identifies the necessity and importance of data collection, and program evaluation with regard to maintaining safe work practices and procedures.

Specific topics in this course:

- The importance of the development, implementation and management of an official written risk management plan.
- Identifying, and maintain knowledge of, occupational safety and health hazards involved in both emergency and non-emergency operations.
- Identifying, and maintain knowledge of, the current principles and techniques of safety management.
- Communicating the health and safety aspects of a risk management plan to all members
